2017 Youth Ambassador Application

The National Ambassador is the spokesperson for the National Brown Swiss Association and represents the breed at local, state and national events including World Dairy Expo, national convention and other national shows. ** As National Youth Ambassador, you will be required to promote the breed at many shows and events.

Requirements

Candidates must be 16-21 years of age as of January 1, 2017, have never been married, own at least one Brown Swiss animal and possess a desire to promote the breed.

Application Process

- 1) Submit Application: Complete application and return it (with your photo) to the national office by March 1.
- 2) Selection of Finalists: Applications will be reviewed and eight finalists will be selected to interview at the 2017 National Convention in Canton, OH. Finalists will be notified by May 15.
- 3) *Interview:* Finalists will be interviewed individually by a panel of three dairy industry professionals on the first day of convention.
- 4) Candidate Introduction: Finalists will introduce themselves during the evening banquet.
- 5) *Impromptu Question*: Finalists will answer a dairy industry/Brown Swiss related impromptu question during the banquet.
- 6) *Ambassador/Alternate Ambassador Selection:* The National Youth Ambassador and Alternate Youth Ambassador winners will be recognized during the banquet.
 - Additional paper may be used if needed to fully answer the questions on this application.

2017 Youth Ambassador Responsibilities

- **A.** Attend National Convention the following year. (Will be reimbursed for convention expenses) (See section D)
 - Assist with Ambassador interviews, emcee Ambassador Contest during convention presentations and give a farewell address, sharing Ambassador experiences.
- **B.** Attend at least one National Show of choice. (Will be reimbursed for show expenses) (See section D)
 - Assist in the show ring and participate in junior member activities at the show.
 - Will NOT exhibit cattle at the show in which participating as Ambassador.
 - Speak with news media about Association junior/other programs by promoting positive attributes of Brown Swiss cattle.
- C. Serve on the Association Youth Committee for two years. (As Ambassador and the following year)

D. Expenses:

• The ambassador shall have an expense fund available of \$1,000.

E. Website/Bulletin:

- The current Ambassador and the previous Ambassador will collaborate to create youth information/articles for the Association Website during the year. (This includes taking and providing pictures of National events for the website)
- They will also write articles for the *Brown Swiss Bulletin* three times during the calendar year. (*January, August, and October issues*).
