

Jiggy is the "Cream" of the Crop

- Sets Breed Fat Record at 2,824 lbs

Lime Rock Frolic Jiggy 927907 has established a new breed record for fat by producing a total of 2,824 pounds of fat in 365 days. Jiggy is owned by Amanda Lee of Sunburst Swiss Farm, DeForest, Wisconsin. Amanda purchased Jiggy as a bred heifer from Lime Rock Swiss Farm of Davis, Illinois.



Jiggy freshened on January 7, 2006, just shy of two years of age. She completed her 305-day record in November and her totals of 33,550 milk, 2504 fat, and 1075 protein, produced on a 3-times-a-day milking

schedule, gave her the top 305d 2X ME Fat record for 2006. Amanda Lee as owner was awarded the prestigious H. R. Searles Trophy at the recent National Convention in Syracuse, New York.

On January 7, 2007, Jiggy completed her 365-day record and took her place in the history books as the new breed champion for fat production with 2,824 pounds of fat. Jiggy's 365-day totals of 37,970 milk, 2,824 fat, and 1,226 protein calculates to a phenomenal 57,814 pounds of Energy Corrected Milk (ECM) for an animal that age. She is now truly the Cream of the Brown Swiss breed for fat production. She replaces Sun-Made Jetway Shatzi ET (M*) 869338 and her record of 2,766 pounds of fat, who continues to remain the breed champion for milk and protein with 53,460 pounds milk and 1,903 pounds protein. Shatzi (M*) is owned by Kent Thompson of Viroqua, Wisconsin.



Jiggy is classified Very Good 85 and has been designated as a "Certified Cow". She is sired by R Hart BC Collection *TM. Her dam, Lime Rock Arna Frolic, is also a "Certified Cow" and has three records up to 32,420 milk, 1,467 fat, and 1,131 protein.

As recently published in the Bulletin, Jiggy now stands as the Under Two Year Old Class Leader for milk, fat, and protein at both 305 and 365 DIM for animals milked 3 times a day. Congratulations to Amanda and Jiggy on this great accomplishment.
